Seeding: *8 racers per gender per school. An additional 2 alternates may be listed for each race. Only listed alternates may be replaced in the race order.

*Coaches may submit different running orders for each race.

*Each seed will be randomly drawn. Each race will be re-drawn.

*Top 4 racers score for team points. Teams with less than 4 racers will not be eligible for team championship. 6 skiers displace for team scoring

Bibs: Bibs will be reassigned and redistributed before the classic race.

*Cell service is very good (US Cellular).

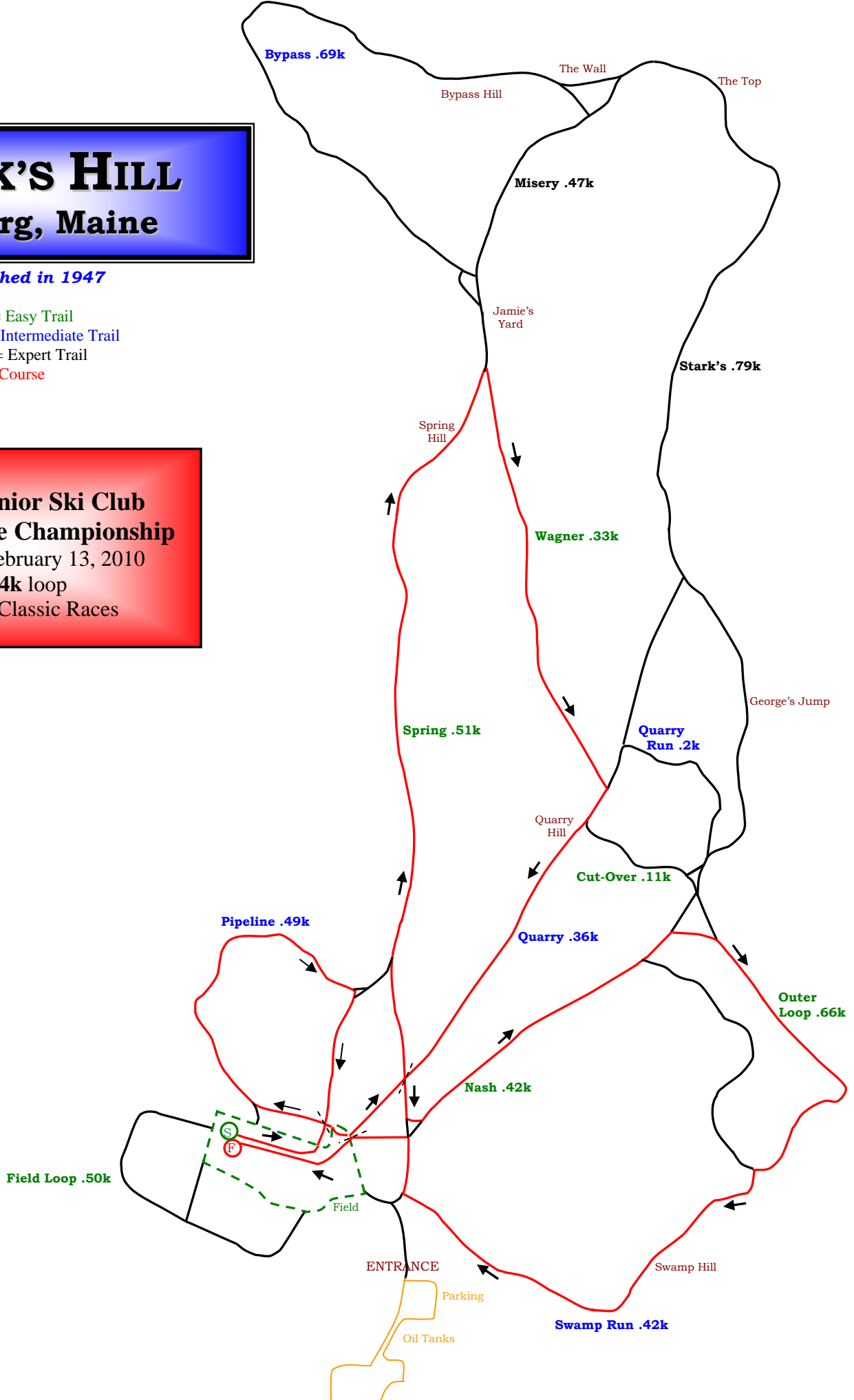

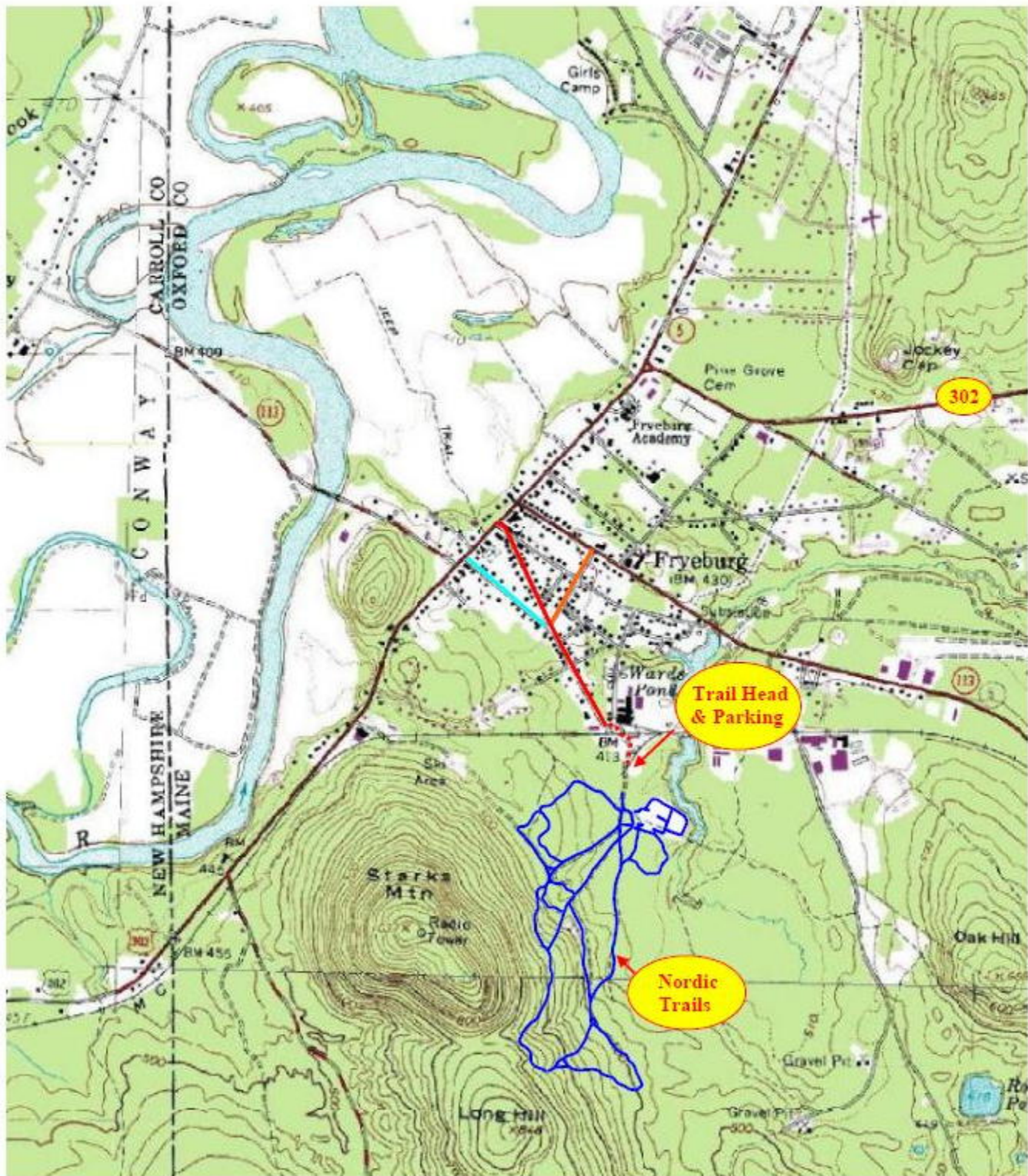
- Green Font= Easy Trail

Stark's Hill Trail System – Fryeburg, Maine

Entering Fryeburg on Route 302 from Bridgton: Continue past Fryeburg Academy (on your left as you enter town) and travel through the traffic light in the center of town. Immediately after the light take the first left onto Oxford Street (just beyond Norway Savings Bank). Oxford Street will immediately fork and stay to the right onto Smith Street (red line on map below). Follow Smith Street to its end in about a half mile where it will take a very sharp left hand turn at a blue factory building called Forest Industries. As the road turns head straight, to the right of the blue factory, toward B & C Autobody (tan colored building). Follow the side road past B & C toward the oil tanks in front of you. You may park anywhere there is room.
